Dress Code Policy

Students in Limerick ETSS are not required to wear a uniform. We encourage diversity and self-expression; however, a dress code is part of the personal education of students. With the support of parents and carers, students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to the school context, which encourages and values individuality and self-expression yet promotes respect. Clothes and shoes worn to school should be appropriate and safe for school. Students will be encouraged to develop an awareness of what is appropriate and safe to wear in a school setting.

For example, jewellery and clothes when worn should not pose health and safety issues in any classes and should not interfere with teaching and learning. Furthermore, in the interest of health and safety, students are not permitted to wear hats or have hoods up during the school day.
